Sponsor(s) of Research: This study is sponsored by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation through the Bill & Melinda Gates Institute for Population and Reproductive Health, Johns Hopkins University, Baltimore, MD. Purpose of research: The purpose of this research is to learn more about your reproductive behavior and to ask questions related to female genital cutting/mutilation in order to provide government and other stakeholders with data to improve interventions and programs aimed at this population.

Procedure of the research, what shall be required of each participant, and approximate total number of participants that would be involved in the research:

We are asking you (or your ward) to join our study because you were interviewed by a member of our team in December 2019/January 2020 or December 2020/January 2021 for a similar survey, and agreed to be contacted again. If you agree to participate in the study, we will ask you (or your ward) some of the same questions we asked before, as well as questions related to female genital cutting/mutilation. The questionnaire should take about 30 minutes to complete. After you (or your ward) complete(s) the survey, you will be provided with recharge cards worth N500.

Expected duration of research, and of participant's involvement: Your participation in the study will only include annual or biannual surveys in-person or by phone.

Risk(s): There are no major risks to participating in the study, but you (or your ward) may get tired or bored when completing the questionnaire. Some questions may be personal or sensitive and may make you (or your ward) feel embarrassed or uncomfortable. Please let us know if you (or your ward) feel distressed.

There is a small risk that someone outside the study will see your (or your ward's) information. We will do our best to keep your (or your ward's) information safe by not including your (or your ward's) name anywhere in the survey. Upon completion of the survey, data will be sent to and stored on a secure, password-protected





server. Only authorized individuals will be able to access the data. All data are encrypted when transferred. When we share your (or your ward's) information with other researchers, we will ask them to use the same protections.

Costs to the participant, if any, of joining the research: Your participation in this research will not cost you anything, apart from some of your (or your ward's) time. Benefit(s): There is no direct benefit to you (or your ward) from being in this study. We hope this knowledge will help us understand about reproductive health issues among women in Lagos. The data collected from this study will provide information for future research, interventions, and programs.
